

ICS nametag Two-fer Block for Block Lotto

December 2010 – February 2011

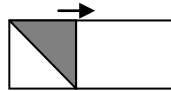
Fabrics: white or white-on-white for background (BG), dark floral for goose (DF)

- Make two triangle squares.** Cut 1 4" square from the BG and DF fabrics. Draw a diagonal line and stitch 1/4" both sides from line. Cut on drawn line and press toward dark fabric. Trim to 3 1/2".

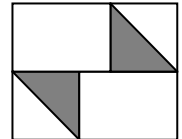


- Cut 2 white rectangles** 3 1/2" x 4 1/2".

- Sew each triangle square to the left end of each rectangle** with the dark against the rectangle and the diagonal seam of the triangle square pointing as shown. Press toward the rectangle.



- Sew the 2 rectangles made in step 3 together** facing opposite directions, but with the triangle square still on the 11-5 o'clock direction. The sewn piece will look like an hour glass with a space between the top and bottom. Be sure to match the outside edges.

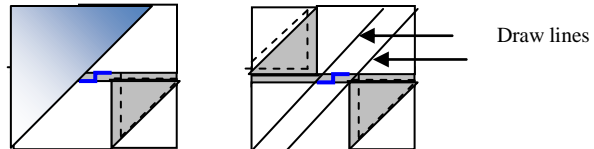


- Clip seam in the center** just through the seam line. Press each seam away from the triangle square.



- Cut 1 dark rectangle** 6 1/2" x 7 1/2". Place right sides together with the hour glass rectangle.

- Mark 2 diagonal stitching lines** through the points on the triangles. Use a ruler with the 45-degree line along the edge of the fabric.



- Sew on both lines.** Cut between the lines, trim to 1/4" seam if desired, open the block and press toward the dark triangle. Blocks should measure 6 1/2" unfinished.
