

Chapstick Holder Instructions



Required supplies are:

- Cut 2 rectangles 6 ½" by 1 7/8"
- Cut 1 square 2" by 2"
- 1 piece Fusible interfacing cut 5 ½" by 1 ½"
- Split ring ¾" or 1" in diameter

1. First prepare the strip for the ring holder.

Take the 2" square and press in half. Open up the crease and fold the raw edges into the center meeting at the fold and press. Re-fold



the first crease and press. Stitch 1/8" from each folded edge.

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- 2. Fuse the interfacing on the wrong side of one rectangle.
- 3. Fold the ring holder strip in half. Center it on one of the short ends of the rectangle with the interfacing. The raw edges of the strip should be even with or slightly off the body piece.
- 4. Place the second rectangle right sides together and sew a ¼" seam all around the piece, leaving an opening for turning. Trim the corners to reduce bulk.





- 5. Turn the piece right side out. Push out the corners. Iron.
- 6. Measure down 3" from the end with the ring and fold up the bottom part of the holder along that 3" measurement. Pin.
- 7. Stitch 1/8" along both sides and the top.
- 8. Add the ring.
