Jar Gripper

Supplies:

- 1 6" x 6" square of 100% cotton colorful fabric
- 1 6" x 6" square of 100% cotton plain fabric (such as muslin)
- 1 6" x 6" square of shelf liner

Instructions:

- 1. Place colorful fabric face up. Then layer with the shelf liner and the plain cotton face down on top. Either use clips or pins to hold the layers together.
- 2. Stitch a 1/4" seam around the square leaving a 3" opening for turning.
- 3. Trim corners and turn right side out. Finger press the edges.
- 4. Stitch around the entire square a little less than ½" from the edge with the shelf liner on top to hold the shape and close the opening.

Notes:

- 1. Using a 6" square allows you to get two 6" pieces from the standard shelf liner. You can make a larger jar gripper by cutting fabric and shelf liner any size you wish.
- 2. You may use any shelf liner, but a thinner thickness works better.
- 3. If you have trouble sewing with the shelf liner on top, place a sheet of paper on top of the shelf liner and then stitch. Tear the paper away after stitching.
