Lanyard instructions

Required supplies are:

- fabric scrap that is approximately 3" x 42".
- Swivel clasp or lobster clasp

1. Fold the strip in half lengthwise so you have a strip 1 ½" by about 42". Press and then open it back up. Next fold each edge to the middle fold mark and then press.

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2. Fold the strip down the middle with both edges also folded in. The strip should be about $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 42". Thread the swivel clasp onto the strip and push it about halfway down the strip.

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ends of the strip and open the folds. Pin the ends together, right sides together and sew. Make sure the lanyard is not twisted. Iron the seam and fold the strip back like it was. >>>>

3. Take the 2 short



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- 4. Next you are going to top stitch the strip about 1/8" from both long edges. Keep pushing the clasp down out of your way and eventually you will come back to where you started. Repeat on the other side.
- 5. Finally position the clasp where you want it and sew across right above the clasp.
