## **Paper Pieced Santa Ornament**

## Supplies:

Paper Piece Pattern Fabric pieces:

- $\circ \quad \text{Face:} \quad 1.25 \text{ in x 4 in}$
- Brim: 1.25 in x 4 in
- $\circ \quad \text{Hat:} \qquad 4 \text{ in } x \text{ 6 in}$
- $\circ$  Beard: 3 in x 4 in
- Back: 4 in x 10
  Bell
  Black embroidery thread
  Hanger



## Process (directions assume basic paper piecing knowledge):

- Place face fabric #1 back-to-back with paper pattern so it covers piece #1 on pattern.
- Place Hat Brim fabric #2 with right sides together (RST) with face fabric #1.
- Sew line between #1 & #2 (using 12-15 stitches per inch).
- Trim seam allowance to  $\sim 1/8$ " and fold fabric #2 open.
- Place Hat Fabric #3 RST on Fabric #2 and sew the line between piece #2 & #3.
- Trim seam allowance to 1/8" and fold Fabric #3 open.
- Place Beard Fabric #4 RST with Fabric #1.
- Sew line between piece #1 & #4.
- Trim seam allowance to 1/8" and fold fabric #4 open.
- At this point you have all 4 pieced fabrics sewn with their backs to the paper pattern. This is a good time to sew the French knots for the eyes.
- Lay backing fabric and pieced Santa fabric RST and sew around the inside pattern line leaving ~2 in unsewn gap in upper part of hat.
- Trim entire pattern to outside line and remove paper pattern.
- Clip curve around beard area about every ½" making sure not to cut through outside seam.
- Turn Santa ornament inside-out and use ball point bodkin to smooth seams and push out points.
- Stitch turning opening in cap shut.
- Fold hat over approximately half down at an angle to give stocking cap appearance.
- Attach hanger (floss, etc) at highest corner of hat fold for hanging.
- Sew bell to pointed end of cap.
