PROJECT BOARD

Supplies: foam board, batting, 2.5 in strip fabric, hot glue gun

Cut foam board to desired size, use OLD rotary cutter or craft knife Cut batting approximately 1 inch larger than board Cut 2.5 in strip fabric long enough to go around edges of board

Fold and press fabric strip in half (wrong side together). Open up and press both edges to meet in middle. Using zigzag stitch sew down center of strip

Lay batting over board. Glue down on all 4 sides, smoothing and stretching to make it flat. Trim batting even with board

Starting in middle of 1 edge of board, run bead of glue to the corner, center strip of fabric along glued edge and gently press down, turn board and continue gluing fabric along all edges of board. To finish, either fold edge under and glue down or trim with pinking shears and glue down covering beginning of fabric strip.

Run bead of glue along free edge of fabric and press down onto board, leaving corners free. Repeat for back of board.

Finger press mitered corners and glue down with just a dot of glue.
